


# All-In-One Wireless Soundbar

# Information for use




Thank you for purchasing this All-In-One Wireless Soundbar from DMD Collective.

This soundbar is your gateway to a world of immersive audio. This sleek, 2.0-channel powerhouse delivers rich, crystal-clear sound that transforms your TV viewing and music listening. Please read through all the information in this document and keep it for future reference.

#### **Health and Safety Guidelines**

- Always unplug the unit when not in use, before cleaning, or when adding or removing parts.
  Please read the instructions carefully before using any appliance.
- Always ensure that the voltage on the rating label corresponds to the mains voltage in your home.
- · Incorrect operation and improper use can damage the appliance and cause injury to the user.
- The appliance is intended for household use only. Commercial use invalidates the warranty, and the supplier cannot be held responsible for injury or damage caused when using the appliance for any other purpose than that intended.
- Warning: This product is not intended for use by children or individuals with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities unless supervised by a responsible adult. Small parts may present a choking hazard. Always keep out of reach of children.
- Check the power cord and plug regularly for any damage. The cord or plug will need to be replaced if it is damaged.



#### **Connecting The Soundbar To TV**




- Connection to TV: Connect a HDMI cable (not included) to the HD Input on the soundbar & the HD (ARC) output on your TV (Fig. 1).
- Alternatively, you can use the AUX cable (included) to connect the 'AUX-IN' port on the soundbar to the Auxiliary out or the Headphone jack on the TV.



# **Connecting The Soundbar To Other Devices**

- Connect the optical input on the soundbar to OPTICAL output of other devices (Blu-ray/DVD player/Gaming consoles) using an optical cable (not included) (Fig.2).
- Other audio sources: You can also connect via bluetooth/AUX-IN (Fig. 3).

# **Operating Instructions**

Once the power adapter is connected to the speaker, the display will light up with a prompt & alert sound which means that the soundbar is successfully powered on. Press and hold the Power/ Mode button on the side panel or the Mode key on the remote control to choose your required mode.

#### **Bluetooth Connect Mode**

- Press the 'MODE' button repeatedly until Bluetooth connect mode is selected. The display will show 'bt'.
- 2. On your Bluetooth-enabled device, choose 'DMDSound-2.0', the name of the sound bar. The display blinks, indicating that it is waiting for pairing, once pairing is successful, the indicator remains on, display shows 'bt' and stops flashing.
- 3. Now you can play music from your Bluetooth-enabled device on the sound bar. Press the rewind or forward button on the remote control to play the previous or next song.

# **Aux Input**

To connect the speaker to audio equipment via Aux cable, select 'AUH' using the Mode key on the remote control or the Power/Mode key on the side panel. 'AUH' will appear on the screen, followed by the 'AUH' prompt.



#### **HD/ARC Input**

If you're using a HDMI cable to connect the speaker to the **HD/ARC** port on your TV. Use the mode button on the remote control or the Power/Mode key on the side plate to select 'ArC'. The screen displays 'ArC' accompanied by the 'ArC' prompt.



**PLEASE NOTE:** Not all TVs support the HDMI function; you may need to adjust your TV's settings. TV settings vary, but you can usually activate PCM mode by going to Settings, Sound Settings, and then selecting the PCM audio output option. You may need to check the TV's HMDI port, which is located near the speaker.

# **Optical Input**

If you're using an optical cable to connect the speaker, select 'OPt' using the mode button on the remote control or the Power/Mode key on the side plate. The screen displays 'OPt', along with the 'OPt' prompt.



#### **Recommended Placement**

Under the TV (if wall-mounted) or in front of it.
