


Double Inflatable Mattress

Please read through all the information in this document and keep it for future reference.




Health and Safety Guidelines

- Always unplug the unit when not in use, before cleaning, or when adding or removing parts. Please read the instructions carefully before using any appliance.
- · Always ensure that the voltage on the rating label corresponds to the mains voltage in your home.
- · Incorrect operation and improper use can damage the appliance and cause injury to the user.
- The appliance is intended for household use only. Commercial use invalidates the warranty, and the supplier cannot be held responsible for injury or damage caused when using the appliance for any other purpose than that intended.
- Do not let children use this appliance unsupervised.
- Check the power cord and plug regularly for any damage. To prevent an electrical hazard, the manufacturer will need to replace the cord or plug if it is damaged.
- To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not immerse or expose the motor assembly, plug, or power cord to water or any other liquid.
- Never immerse the unit in water or any other liquid for cleaning purposes. Do not reach for an appliance that has fallen into the water. Unplug immediately.
- Remove the plug from the socket by gripping the plug. Do not pull on the cord to disconnect the appliance from the mains.
- Injury, fire, or electric shock could result from the use of accessory attachments that the manufacturer has not approved or supplied.
- A short cord is provided to reduce the hazards resulting from becoming entangled in or tripping over a longer cord.
- Do not let the cord hang over the edge of a table or counter, ensure that the cord is not in a position where it can be pulled inadvertently.
- Do not allow the cord to touch hot surfaces, and do not place it on or near a hot gas or electric burner or in a heated oven. Do not place the unit on a hot surface.
- This appliance is not suitable for outdoor use. Do not use this appliance for anything other than its intended purpose.
- Do NOT carry the unit by the power cord.
- The manufacturer does not accept responsibility for any damage or injury caused by improper or incorrect use or for repairs carried out by unauthorised personnel.
- In the event of technical problems, switch off the appliance and do not attempt to repair it yourself. Return the appliance to an authorised service facility for examination, adjustment, or repair.
- Always insist on the use of original spare parts. Failure to comply with the above-mentioned precautions
 and instructions will affect the safe operation of this machine.
- Do not use the pump consistently for over 4 minutes. Turn off the pump as soon as the mattress has reached the desired firmness. Take 15 minutes break before you use it again.
- Do not smoke on or near the mattress, avoid burning candles, matches, or lighters near the mattress. Keep heaters and fires at a safe distance from the mattress.
- · Never use heated blankets with the mattress.
- Do not place hot items on the mattress, such as hairdryers or hair straighteners.
- We do not recommend using extension cords with this product.
- Wherever possible, avoid creams or emollients containing paraffin. If you use them, make sure to wash
 the bedding more frequently.
- WARNING: Risk of Suffocation: Never place an infant 15 months of age or younger on an inflatable
 mattress. When used by children over 15 months old, you should provide at least a shoulder width of
 space between the mattress and walls, a dresser, or other vertical objects to avoid entrapment. Always
 keep the mattress fully inflated when in use.
- · Keep pets away from the mattress; they may puncture the surface.
- Avoid walking, standing, jumping, or using the mattress as a trampoline.
- Do not set up the bed near stairs, doors, sharp edges, or breakable objects. Provide adequate space between the mattress and objects to avoid entrapment.
- Make sure the area is flat, smooth, and free of sharp objects that could puncture the mattress. Keep away from ledges.

- · Avoid sleeping on the edge of the mattress. Edges provide less support than the middle of the bed.
- Don't run cable under carpeting. Do not cover the cable with throw rugs, runners, or similar coverings. Do not route cables under furniture or appliances.

Inflate Your Mattress

- 1. Find a suitable location near a power source, then fully unroll the mattress and lay it flat on the floor.
- 2. Remove the plug from the plastic housing on the mattress and connect it to the mains supply.
- 3. Turn the dial to the inflate position (Fig. 1), and the mattress will inflate automatically. Once the mattress has reached the desired firmness, turn the dial to the off position (Fig. 2). Do not overinflate
- 4. To test firmness, press down or lie on the airbed. If the sleeping surface is too hard, adjust the firmness by turning the control dial counter clockwise gradually until air starts to exit through the air passage. Once you achieve the desired firmness, turn the dial position to "OFF".
- 5. Unplug the mattress from the main supply, and return the plug to its housing. The mattress is now fully inflated and ready to use.






Deflate Your Mattress

- 1. Remove the plug from the plastic housing on the mattress & plug into the mains supply.
- 2. Turn the dial to the 'Deflate' position (Fig.3), the mattress will deflate automatically. Once the mattress has fully deflated turn the dial to the off position (Fig.4).
- 3. Unplug the mattress from the mains supply & return the plug to it's housing.




