To Insert or Replace Battery

- On the base of the scale, gently remove the battery cover as per the arrow direction. And install 2x AAA batteries in the correct position & replace the battery cover.
- **Notice:** Please ensure that the batteries are inserted in the correct position, as any incorrect installation may result in irreversible damage to the electronic components of the scale.

LCD Display





Error Indication

The display will show a negative value if a weight has been removed from the scale. Please touch the "power/tare" button to clear the negative value until the display shows "0" again.



The "Lo" symbol on the display indicates that the battery power is running low. Please insert new batteries.



The "Err" symbol on the display indicates that the scale is overloaded. The maximum weight limit of this scale is 5kg.

Operation

- 1. Before use, place the scale on a solid, flat surface. Place any container or bowl (if any) on the scale before operation.
- 2. Gently touch the "power/tare" button to turn on the scale.
- 3. Wait until "0" is shown on the display.
- 4. Place the item to be weighed on the scale (or in the bowl if required). The LCD display will show the weight result.
- 5. After weighing, touch the "power/tare" button for three seconds to turn off the scale. Or leave the scale, and it will automatically power off within 2 minutes of inactivity.

Unit Conversion

 While the scale is on, select the required unit by pressing the "unit" button until the correct unit is displayed. The scale will cycle between lb:oz/fl'oz (water mode), fl'oz (milk mode) g/ml (water mode), ml (milk mode).



Tare function

Imagine this scenario: You're about to weigh your dinner using the Smart Kitchen Scale, but you realize that the plate will contribute extra weight to your measurement. No need to go through the hassle of weighing the empty plate, then the full plate, and doing the calculations. With a simple press of the tare button after your empty plate is on the scale, the tare feature instantly resets the scale to zero and automatically subtracts the weight of the bowl or plate from your measurement. This convenient function ensures that you can easily view the precise weight of your portion without the need for any manual calculations.

- 1. Gently touch the "power/tare" button to turn on the scale.
- 2. Wait until "0" is shown on the display. Put the container on the scale platform.
- 3. The LCD display will show the steady weight of the container.
- 4. Touch the "power/tare" button to clear the weight of the container (reset to zero).
- 5. The lower-left corner will show the "tare weight" icon, which means the tare function is activated.
- 6. Add the items you want to weigh to the container.
- 7. The LCD will show the weight of the subject only.
- 8. Repeat touching the "power/tare" button to weigh new different ingredients.

Fitdays+ App

Download the free Fitdays+ App from the App store or Google play or scan the QR code on the information card provided.

App Operation

Download and install the Fitdays+ App on your device. Once the app is installed, the system will remind you to open the Bluetooth function first.



- 1. Register your email account (Fig. 1 & 2). The app may send a verification code to your email. Please check your junk folder if you did not receive.
- 2. Add your personal data, age, height, gender to get an accurate result (Fig. 3).

- Press the scale power button to turn on scale, then go to the "Device" page to add a new device. The app will search for nearby devices, Select the scale. (Figs. 4,5 & 6).
- After connection with the scale, you can weigh the foods. (Fig. 7)
- From the "Measuring" page (Fig. 7), touch the "+" icon, You can search the food you are weighing by inputting the food name, or you can search for it via the Nutrition Library (Fig. 8). There are currently 1600 types of food listed in the system. When you search out the food you need, press to check its content, and select it.

- After weighing, and selecting the food code info, the APP will show the nutritional composition data to you, including Calories, Protein, Fat, Carbohydrate. Dietary Fiber, Vitamin A, Carotene and etc. (Fig. 9) Press "Save" to add it to your daily record.
 - You can check the record for the food you have weighed by pressing "Trend". The "Trend" page will show you the values for today, daily & average (Figs. 10, 11 & 12).
 - On the "More" page, you have access to various functions, including device management, and unit switching (Fig. 13).
