
Health and Safety Guidelines

- Always unplug the unit when not in use, before cleaning, or when adding or removing parts.

- Always ensure that the voltage on the rating label corresponds to the mains voltage in your home.

- Check the power cord and plug regularly for any damage. The cord or plug will need to be replaced if it is damaged.
- Do not use the appliance if it has been dropped or damaged in any way. If the unit is damaged, take it in for examination and/or repair by an authorized service agent.
- To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not immerse or expose the assembly, plug, or power cord to water or any other liquid.
- Never immerse the unit in water or any other liquid for cleaning purposes. Do not reach for an
 appliance that has fallen into the water. Unplug immediately.

- Do not allow grease, dust, moisture, smoke, oils or chemicals to come into contact with the projector.



Remote Control Functions



Power ON/OFF


Power On: Press the projector's power button for three seconds.

Power Off: When turned on, press and hold the power button on the projector or remote.

When you first start projector follow the instructions displayed to do the initial set up, use the left & right keys on the top of the projector.

Auto Keystone Correction

After the initial set up the projector detects any distortion of the image and then electronically adjusts the image shape so that it appears rectangular on the screen. Improving viewing experience and image quality. To adjust the angle further you can also use the right & left buttons on top of the projector.





Remote Control Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Hold down the left and right keys on the remote control. Indicator lights will flash, and the Bluetooth interface will activate (Fig 3).
- 2. Once successfully paired you will be taken to settings > Remote & Accessories menu, select "JVIN" and connect.



Focus Adjustment


When the projector is turned on & the image appears blurry, use the remote control's focus buttons to adjust the lens position.

Home Screen


From the home screen you can access a variety of functions & access the device settings. Choose your preferred main background in the top right corner of the interface.



Settings


From here you can connect to your WiFi connection & bluetooth devices, change the date & time & language (Fig.6).

Language

File Manager


Insert a USB flash drive (not supplied), click the File Manager icon on the homepage & External Devices to access local video, music, photo, and books.


